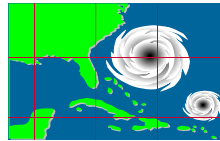

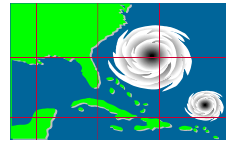
CANOE AND KAYAK
