PREPARE FOR THE FREEZE



As fall approaches, we must remember that Old Man Winter is not far behind. Winterizing your rig is a most important aspect of trailer life.

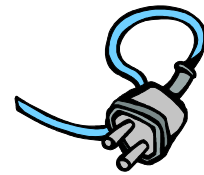
For those campers wishing to have the winterizing done through the campground office, you must stop by and get the winterizing form and make sure that we have a key to your trailer or RV. Additionally, you must remove your water hose and any "Y"

connectors that are attached to your spigot.

It is a good idea to apply a UV protectant to the roof of your camper, as one of the main causes of roof cracking is Ultra-violet light.

In an effort to keep critters from nesting inside your hot water compartment, metal mesh placed behind the access door is a good way to help keep the animals out.

Make sure the main circuit breaker in your rig is turned off as well as the circuit breaker in your exterior electrical box. PLEASE close the lid!!!



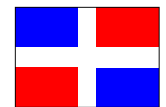
